SUMMONS

The Netherlands Antillean Swimming Federation (NAZB) extends to you a cordial invitation to participate in the **11th Annual Dutch Caribbean Invitational Swimming Competition**, to be held in Curacao from April 29th – May 2nd, 2010.

Swimming pool: Sentro Deportivo Korsow
Course: 8 lanes, 50 meter pool.

A. Rules

FINA rules (most recent edition) will be in effect. For the **11th Annual Dutch Caribbean Invitational Swimming Championships**, the following age categories will be applicable:

Age Groups

- Individual Events -				
6 - 8	9 - 10	11 – 12	13 – 14	15 & Over
- Relays -				
6 - 8	9 - 10	11 – 12	13 – 14	15 & Over

The age of the swimmer on Midnight December 31st 2009 will determine the age group in which the swimmer is eligible to swim.
In the open events the minimum age is 11 years old.

B. Format

There will be timed finals. Events 200 Back, 200 Fly, 200 Breast, 400 Free, 400 IM, will be open events (11 years & over). Except for 800 free, that is divided in 11/12 male and 11/ 12 and 13 & over female and 1500 Free (male 13 and over). Starts are overhead.

C. Dates of Competition

The Technical Meeting will be held at the Sentro Deportivo Korsou at 20:00 pm on Wednesday, April 28th, 2010.

The Opening Ceremony (including a parade of all participating club, in their official club uniform) will take place on Friday, April 30th, starting at **9:00am.**

Coaches are requested to submit their scratches ½ hour prior to each session.

Session 3:	Saturday, May 1 st	timed finals 9:00 am
Session 4:	Sunday, May 2 nd	timed finals 9:00 am

D. Registration & Entries

Swimmers must be sanctioned by their respective National Federations and be in good standing with their club and National Federation. Each participating club must present a "Letter of Good Standing" from their National Federation, sanctioning their participation.

Later in January 2009 the order of events along with a HY-TEK TM file of the meet events will be sent to each of the invited club, in order to facilitate their entry process. Also we need a list with all names and positions (swimmers, Coach, officials and so on)

Preliminary Entries in each discipline must be made using the preliminary Entry forms attached and must reach the Meet Directors by March 23th, 2010.

Final entries, including those for the relays, must be returned to the Organizing Committee by, **April 18th 2010**, preferably in HY-TEK format, at the following address:

The following rules will apply to all entries:

1. A club may enter a **maximum of four (4) swimmers per event**. The first eight **(8)** competitors of each event will score points, but only the first two **(2)** swimmers of each club will score points for their respective club.
2. Each Club may enter a maximum of two **(2)** clubs per relay event, however only one **(1)** will score points.
3. Swimmers of age group 8 & Under and 9-10 may participate in two(2) individual events plus one **(1)** relay event per session. According to the rules of the event, swimmers of age group **8 & Under are only allowed to swim the 50 m events, the 4x 50 m relay events, the 100 m Freestyle**
4. Swimmers of other age groups (11 and over) may participate in three **(3)** **individual** events plus one (1) relay event per session.
5. **Swimmers competing in relay events must be registered at the technical meet at the latest. Relay only swimmers will be accepted,**
6. For an event to be held there should be at least one (1) participant or relay club.

E. PROTESTS

All protests to the Referees' Decision must be submitted to the referee in writing within 30 minutes after the event, signed by the Club Manager of the delegation and accompanied by US \$25. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Delegation's leader.

F. JURY OF APPEAL

- A. There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.
- B. The Jury of Appeal shall be comprised of 3 disinterested persons pointed by NAZB.

G. Awards and scoring

- ***Medals and ribbons***

In individual events, medals will be awarded to the first three (**3**) places. There will be ribbons for place 4 to 8 for the age-group 8 & under and 9/10. **In relay events**, medals will be awarded only to the first place

- ***Scoring***

Scoring shall be as follows:

First Place	-	9 points
Second Place	-	7 points
Third Place	-	6 points
Fourth Place	-	5 points
Fifth Place	-	4 points
Sixth Place	-	3 points
Seventh Place	-	2 points
Eighth Place	-	1 point

Relays will be awarded double points.

- ***Trophies***

The club scoring the highest overall number of points shall be declared the winning club and shall receive a trophy. Trophies will also be given to the 2nd and 3rd placed club in the competition. Additionally there will be a trophy awarded to the highest point winners in each age group (male and female).

Club trophies will be presented after the medals of the last event have been presented. Ribbons will be given to club delegates.

H. Entry fees

Each club is responsible for payment of the following entry fees:

- US\$100.00 per club
- US\$ 5.00 for every individual participant , and
- US\$ 5.00 for each relay entry.

Entry fees should be paid prior to or during the technical meeting.

I. Officials

Overseas club are invited to submit the names of any qualified person willing to serve as Timekeeper / Judge during the meet, along with their entries.

Local clubs are required to submit the names of at least 3 officials per session and 1 additional official for every 10 swimmers, together with their entries.

Official will get a white t-shirt. This has to be wear with white pants.

J. Warm-up schedule

The pool will be open for warm-up one and a half (1 ½) hours before each session.

K. Refreshments

Food and drinks will be available on the premises, throughout the meet.

L. Accommodation

Each participating club is responsible for their own air transportation, visa and accommodation costs (hotel, meals and transportation). A list of hotels will be provided to help you in choosing a location.

We look forward to welcoming all of you to Curaçao for the **11th Annual Dutch Caribbean Invitational Swimming Competitions.**
